



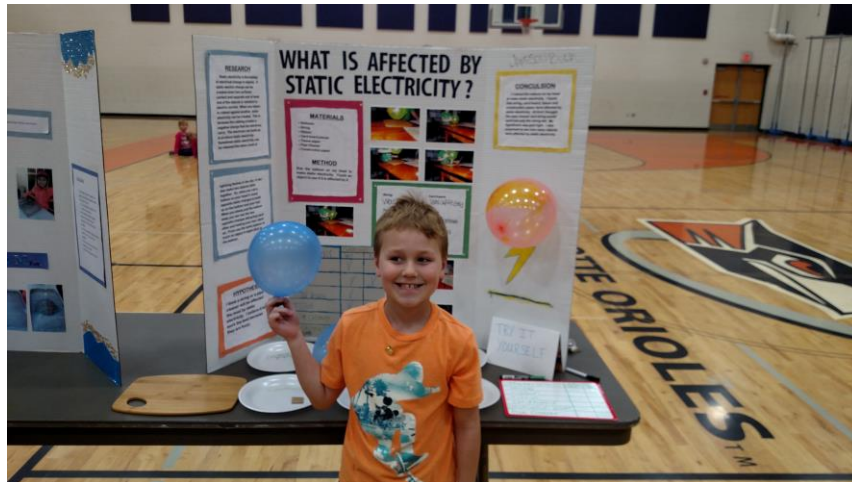
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### **Charlotte Students Show Off Their Science Knowledge**
