### **CHS COMPETITIVE CHEER RECEIVES ACADEMIC HONORS**



Each year the Competitive Cheerleading Coaches Association of Michigan (CCCAM) recognizes teams and athletes at the conclusion of the season for their academic excellence. To be considered for the Academic All-State Team honor, the team's average cumulative GPA at the end of the first semester or trimester of the current year must be greater than or equal to 3.0. Charlotte High Schools' Competitive Cheerleading Team has received Academic All-State honors since 2007, which is the first season Charlotte competed under the MHSAA competitive cheerleading format. Last year the team finished fourth in the state with a 3.5230 GPA and this year moved to a second place finish with a 3.675 overall team GPA.

To receive an individual Academic All-State recognition an athlete needs to have a minimum overall GPA of a 3.8 (un-rounded) by the end of the first semester or trimester of the current school year. This year 12 of Charlotte's competitive cheer athletes received individual All-State honors.
