The Eaton County Sheriff's Office, the Charlotte Police Department and the Charlotte Public Schools will be conducting an active violence training on June 29, 2016 at Charlotte High School, 378 State St, Charlotte, MI. The high school campus will be closed to the general public. Eaton County Sheriff's Office along with several area police departments including Charlotte Police Department, Michigan State Police, Eaton Rapids Police Department, Potterville Police Department, Olivet Police Department and Bellevue Police Department are participating along with Charlotte Fire Department, Delta Township Fire and EMS, Windsor Township Fire/EMS, Grand Ledge Fire and EMS, Benton Township Fire and EMS, Potterville City Fire Department and Sunfield Township Fire Department, and Eaton Area EMS. We will be working in conjunction with Hayes Green Beach Hospital and the American Red Cross.

There will be staff from several local schools participating including, Charlotte, Maple Valley, and Williamston. Training seminars have been held with local fire departments as we train for police to escort medical staff into treat injured as soon as possible. We are using the knowledge and lessons learned from law enforcement and EMS response to previous active violence incidents across the country to be well prepared and respond effectively to protect lives in Eaton County and our tri-county area.

Negotiators from Clinton County and Eaton County as well as Eaton County SRT team will be involved.
