Make Up Day – Parkview Elementary

Parkview Elementary was closed this winter on Tuesday, January 13, 2015, due to a power outage, leaving Parkview with one additional closure day than the other buildings. Therefore, Parkview Elementary students will attend school on Friday, March 13, 2015, for a half day from 9:00 a.m. until 12 noon.

In order for Parkview students to be on the same calendar as the balance of the school district, we needed to identify a day within the existing calendar to make up a day of instruction per State of Michigan requirements. Thus, March 13th was identified as the only day off left in the school calendar that is not attached to Spring Break or Memorial Day weekend. Once the day of instruction is made up, the entire school district will end together on the same day at the end of the school year.

The staff at Parkview will have the half day instructional activities centered on “March is reading month”.

Transportation services will still be provided. Breakfast will be served but, lunch will not.

Winter weather circumstances will still pose concerns and potential closures, but getting Parkview aligned with the entire district will greatly assist us with end of the school year activities and events.
