The Charlotte Early Middle College Bulldog Academy represents a unique opportunity for students to earn college credits while still in high school. In order for students to successfully graduate from the academy, they must agree to the following conditions:

1. Complete all graduation requirements as outlined by the State of Michigan and Charlotte Public Schools. See the attached document for specifics.
2. During the 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade years, enroll in and pass the following courses and programs:
  - Woodbridge I - 16 credits
  - Woodbridge II - 14 credits
  - Political Science 121 – 3 credits
  - Political Science 122 – 3 credits
3. During the 13<sup>th</sup> year, the student must enroll in and pass 24 credits at LCC and FSU, including at least one math class.

Failure to complete any of these requirements means that the student will not graduate and earn a Charlotte Early Middle College diploma. It is important to note that students will be enrolled in the Charlotte Early Middle College entity; however, students still have the opportunity to participate in all sports, clubs, and activities in which students in the Charlotte High School entity can participate. Students will earn their high school credits through CHS classes with CHS teachers, but will be graduates of the Charlotte Early Middle College.
