RECORD BREAKING TRACK SEASON FOR ORIOLES



The Charlotte Public Schools' varsity track teams had a record breaking 2015 season! The men's and women's teams not only broke long standing records, but produced nine (9) All State and nine (9) All State Academic winners!

The women's team finished 4th, their highest in recent years, at the regional competition held at Mason High School. Twelve team members qualified for the State finals in six events. The women's team also finished 3rd at the I-8 league meet at Marshall High School. Charlotte produced seventeen (17) All Conference athletes, including conference champions: Ally Goeman, Mikayla Skowronski, Valery Osgood, Brianna Hasler, Maddie Grace, and Emily Helfrich.

The ladies concluded their season with an excellent showing at the State Meet. The team finished with 17th place overall. Ally Goeman broke the 1984 school record in the 200M dash and also received All State and Academic All State awards. Emily Helfrich also received All State and Academic All State awards and place 3rd in the high jump.

The men's team finished 5th in the regional competition and had seven team members qualify in four events for the State finals. The men's team finished 2nd overall at the I-8 league meet with an outstanding twenty-five (25) athletes qualifying for All Conference! Conference champions included Tyler Davis, Miles Garn, Sy Barnett, Justin Holmer, Justin Anderson, Ethan Thuma, and Jared Dewey. The Charlotte men



placed 1st or 2nd in nine of the seventeen events.

The men's team also finished the season very strong. The men's team finished at the State meet in 11th place, the best finish since 2005. The men's season resulted in six All State athletes: Miles Garn, Justin Holmer, Justin Anderson, Tyler Davis (4x800 relay and 800), and Sy Barnett.
