Mr. Blair’s students constructed 30 wooden birdhouses as a class project to donate to Washington Elementary. At the start of the 2015-2016 school year the Charlotte Optimist Club generously donated the funds and the time to put the birdhouses up for display around the perimeter of the Washington Elementary playground.

The third grade students will be feeding the birds throughout the winter months in hopes that some birds will find a safe and comfortable home here at Washington.
