On Wednesday, March 14th, 2018, Charlotte High School social studies teachers Brent Crossman and John Moran accompanied students from the CHS Ferris State University political science courses and Advanced Placement Government to the Center for Michigan Bridge Magazine's *2018 Solutions Summit*. The event was held in the Huntington Club overlooking Spartan Stadium on the campus of MSU.
