We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-2018 educational progress for Charlotte Upper Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by Federal law, and meets some of the requirements of State laws. For 2017- 2017 Charlotte Upper Elementary received a rating of 73.04 on the state scale. This rating is the result of combining our Growth Index, Proficiency Index, School Quality and Success Index, and Assessment Participation. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff, and our community as we strive to continually improve our school for our students.

In addition to the facts and figures you will find in the Annual Report, we want to share the following information with you:

1. Charlotte Public School District has centralized enrollment that assigns students to a school based on residency boundaries established by the district. Charlotte Public Schools also participates in Schools of Choice.
2. Charlotte Upper Elementary strives to ensure that it is meeting the needs of all learners. To those ends, we set school improvement goals that define success in the following ways:

SMART Goals

- Charlotte Upper Elementary provides instruction for students in grades four through six.
- 80% of all students at Charlotte Upper Elementary will be proficient in reading as demonstrated in a state standardized test.
- 80% of all students at Charlotte Upper Elementary will be proficient in math as demonstrated in a state standardized test.
- 80% of all students at Charlotte Upper Elementary feel safe as measured by perception surveys.
- 60% of families attend at least one formal Parent-Teacher conference by the end of each school year.
