Your application will be processed and notification of eligibility will be mailed to you. We are able to apply for grant money, which helps our children in many ways when you complete the application. Your family information is kept confidential.

IF YOU RECEIVED FREE OR REDUCED PRICE MEALS LAST SCHOOL YEAR, YOU ARE APPROVED FOR THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF SCHOOL. AFTER THIS TIME YOUR CHILD WILL BE CHARGED FULL PRICE FOR THEIR MEALS.

If you qualify for free lunch, you also qualify for free breakfast.

RETURNED CHECK GUIDELINE

When our department receives a returned check from a banking institution, a contact will be made by phone or letter to the person that wrote the check. We will debit your account in the amount of the NSF check. In addition, a returned check fee of \$25.00 will be withdrawn from your family food service account.

You have a maximum of five (5) days to repay the amount of the returned check and fee. If this timeline is not met the case will be turned over to our Business Office for legal action. If this deduction results in a negative balance, it would lead to a stop being applied to your account and no further student charges allowed.

If two checks are returned from the same bank account to Charlotte Public Schools, we will no longer accept checks as payment on your family food account. We will only accept payment by cash or money order.

FOOD SERVICE PAYMENTS

CPS operates a **computerized** debit system for your child's meals at school. Accounts are set up by families with sales being drawn from your account. Payments can be deposited by cash/check/money orders on your account. Envelopes will be available at Elementary level and CUE level for payments. Payments can be made at point of sale by your student or returned to school with your child. **We strongly encourage you to maintain a minimum balance of \$10 in your account at all times to avoid the possibility of a hold on lunch and breakfast purchases.**

Electronic deposits can be made on your account at www.charlottenet.org → Parent tab → efunds. Create your own user name, password and call our office for your family pin number, 541-5140.
