SCHOOL INFORMATION

- ❑ At Washington we encourage and welcome parent engagement. If you plan on volunteering, attending field trips or being in the building during the school day, you must have a cleared background check on file. Forms are available in the office and you must present a valid driver's license or state id when submitting the form. These forms can take up to 7 business days to process.
- ❑ Please remember to complete and return the student information cards and the concussion awareness and handbook acknowledgment forms.
- ❑ If your child is on medication that must be administered during the school day, you must come to the office and complete the appropriate paperwork. If it is a prescription medication, the paperwork will also need to be completed by the primary physician before it can be administered.
